WHY THE MERAKI EDIT

For the way I always wanted to give.

*There is a moment every year, a week before Rakhi, when I open a drawer, and
everything I have chosen feels almost right, but not quite.*

For as long as I can remember, every time I wanted to give a gift that truly meant something for Rakhi, for a wedding, for a brother turning older, for a sister who had been carrying too much quietly I would end up doing it the long way. Sourcing pieces one by one. A candle from here. A box of mithai from there. Something handwritten for the card. And then I would sit at the dining table, past midnight, wrapping it all in something that felt like me something with weight, with warmth, with the kind of care a person you love actually deserves.

Because every ready-made hamper I had ever bought felt the same. Pretty on the outside, hollow on the inside. Goodie packs in nicer paper. Nothing anyone would want to keep past the week.

*The Meraki Edit is the gift I wished I could buy. The one I kept composing for myself, by hand, late on Saturday nights — chosen slowly, wrapped carefully, finished with the kind of attention that quietly says:
this is for you, and only you.*

Every object here has been sourced from a maker I trust. The silver, cast by hand in a small studio. The ghee is slow cultured from cows that graze on real grass. The attar was distilled the old way, one drop at a time. The packaging, made to be kept.

This is my Rakhi gift to you from one sibling who loves fiercely to another.

CURATED IN TWO DIRECTIONS

*Two ways
to gift this Rakhi.*

A rakhi is a promise made in silver, in thread, in cotton. And a gift, when it is chosen well, is the way that promise arrives at the doorstep of someone you love. This year, we have quietly curated two collections — one for the brother she still teases at the dinner table, one for the sister who has always known him better than he knew himself.

RAKHI 01

*For Him,
from Her.*

For the brother who still calls to check the weather. Silver rakhis cast by hand. Attars of oudh and shamama that will live on his dressing table for years. Slow-cultured ghee. Small brass keepsakes for the desk, the shelf, the memory of the sister he has always adored.

RAKHI 02

*For Her,
from Him.*

For the sister who taught you how to laugh at yourself. Attar of mogra and rose. Hand-poured candles for the evenings she keeps for herself. Silk that carries the mark of the karigar. Home objects that will quietly make her room feel more like her.

HOW THE EDITS WORK

Pick any objects from either collection. We compose your hamper by hand and complete it with our complimentary Rakhi ritual kit: kumkum, akshat, mishri and khat. Because no gift for Rakhi is complete without the ceremony that made it a gift in the first place.

The ceremony, prepared by hand.

Hand-blended kumkum in a small brass pot. A deep, ceremonial red, untouched by synthetic colour.



Akshat — Whole-Grain Rice

Long-grain basmati, hand-cleaned and tinted gold with a whisper of turmeric. In a folded paper sachet.



Mishri — Rock-Sugar Crystals

Hand-broken mishri, traditional to the ritual. A small ceramic pot, refillable, designed to keep.



Khat — The Letter

A thoughtfully crafted personal note on luxurious handmade cotton paper, sealed with our signature wax monogram. Because heartfelt words make every gift unforgettable.

THE SILVER RAKHI

Every hamper is completed with a silver rakhi of your choosing, hand-cast in 925 sterling silver — selected from our silver rakhi menu overleaf, priced separately.

Each rakhi is hand-cast in 925 sterling silver by a small karigar's studio in Jaipur, finished with semi-precious stones or a hand-braided thread. A rakhi is a promise made in silver. Every piece is designed to be kept — long after the day, long after the thread comes off.

Every Meraki Edit hamper is composed by hand. Some things — the silver rakhis, the hand-embroidered scarves, the jewellery — are made to order. This is why we ask for time.

I.

Write to us & compose

Pick any objects from either edit. Write to us, and we return a considered, itemised quote with GST for each category noted individually.

II.

Confirm & we craft

On confirmation of the quote, we ask a 50% advance to begin work. Our karigars start cutting, casting, embroidering and pouring the same week.

III.

We deliver, to your door

Delivery within 3–4 weeks anywhere in India. 4–5 weeks for anywhere overseas. Free Shipping is included with every order. Balance settled on dispatch.

TERMS . GENTLY NOTED

A few practical, tender things.

- **Pricing.** Every hamper is priced on request. GST rates differ across silver jewellery, edibles, textiles, home objects and personal fragrance — we prefer to send a considered, itemised quote for every conversation.
- **Shipping.** Free shipping is included with every order. India, 3–4 weeks. Overseas, 4–5 weeks.
- **Advance.** 50% on confirmation, balance on dispatch. This lets us pay our karigars promptly for their time.
- **Cancellation.** Because each hamper is made to order, only 25% of the advance is refundable on cancellation.
- **The handwritten letter.** Complimentary with every hamper — a note in your own words, calligraphed on hand-made cotton paper and sealed with wax.
- **Silver.** All silver rakhis, cufflinks and jewellery are hand-cast in 925 sterling silver.
